AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FALSE ALARM FEES

WHEREAS, substantial costs and expenses are expended and incurred by the Village in responding to false alarms caused by mechanical failure, malfunction and other reasons; and

WHEREAS, the terms of Chapter 8.72 of the North Riverside Municipal Code regulates the installation and use of various alarms systems within the Village including fines which are required to be paid in the event of a false alarm; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees, after due deliberation and consideration, have determined that it will be in the best interest of the Village to revise the payments which are required to be made to the Village in the event of false alarms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Riverside, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 8.72.1210 of the North Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

i. Item A. is hereby deleted and substituted therefor is the following:

A. One false alarm in any single calendar year: no charge.

ii. Item B. is hereby deleted and substituted therefor is the following:

B. Two or more false alarms in any single calendar year: three hundred (\$300.00) dollars for each false alarm to which the Fire Department is intended or expected to respond and one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each false alarm to which the Police Department is intended or expected to respond.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: If any term or provision of this Ordinance shall be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and each term and provision of this Ordinance shall be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. The amendments described in Section 1 above shall be effective as of January 1, 2005.
