**MAYORAL REPORT**

Mayor Hermanek gave the following Community Development Department updates:

- Presales- As of February 15<sup>th</sup>, the Community Development Department performed 9 single-family presale inspections totaling \$3,731.25 in revenue.
- Permit Totals- The Community Development Department issued 27 residential and commercial permits totaling \$11,140.07 in revenue.
- Raising Cane’s-The restaurant food chain will be submitting construction drawings for lot #3 of the Costco Development by mid- March.
- Big Dollar- Located in North Riverside Park Mall closed for business, with the tenant space already re-occupied by UNO, a retail clothing store.
- Pancho’s Taco’s (7329 W. 25<sup>th</sup> Street)- Obtained a video gaming license from the State of Illinois and the Village of North Riverside.

Mayor Hermanek stated that he recently directed the public works department to extend the lengths of the yellow curbs on the east and west sides of 22<sup>nd</sup> and Hainsworth, 22<sup>nd</sup> and
