

NORTH RIVERSIDE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2022

PURPOSE: To award postsecondary educational scholarships to eligible North Riverside students. Funds are available for this purpose due to the generosity of local businesses and individual sponsors who participate in Mayor's Annual Golf Outing.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be:

1. A citizen of the United States;
2. A North Riverside resident for at least 1 year;
3. under the age of 25; and
4. successfully admitted or currently enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college/university, vocational school, industrial school, or a post-high school program preparing for full-time employment.

SELECTION INFORMATION:

Scholarship winners will be selected by the Youth Scholarship Committee. Decisions will be based on various factors, including character, community involvement, financial need, and seriousness of pursuing postsecondary education. Those awarded scholarships will be notified by mail. Checks for the scholarship amount will be issued directly to the institution the student attends after a bill has been submitted to the Youth Scholarship Committee.

HOW TO APPLY: Submit the following:

1. Completed application
2. A copy of your driver's license or state identification card
3. Minimum of two letters of recommendation from adults not related to you. (Suggestions: teachers, employers, neighbors)
4. Written Essay (approximately 250 words) explaining what type of education you are pursuing and why you are interested in that area.

Any application missing any of the above will NOT be considered for a scholarship, no exceptions.

HOW TO SUBMIT COMPLETED APPLICATIONS:

Scholarship applications are due by May 2, 2022.
